The Salary Survey Committee met in January and discussed the decline in response rate to the Salary Survey, and possible ways to improve member participation. The Salary Survey Committee issued an email notice to all members on January 30, 2015, seeking suggestions to improve the response rate, and to encourage more participation of members who graduated more than 15 years ago.

A number of valuable suggestions were received from the members, including: a shorter survey that is easier to complete; questioning the required frequency of the survey; a variety of incentives were suggested to complete the survey, such as receiving 1 hour of PD time, gift cards, etc.; using Survey Monkey; and many more.

After carefully considering the various suggestions, the Salary Survey Committee unanimously voted to cancel the survey for 2015 in order to allow the committee time to properly review the suggestions received from the membership, and to rethink and reconfigure the salary survey for 2016.

The committee will be convening in September to review the earlier feedback, consider alternatives to the existing survey format, and if appropriate, start to reconfigure the salary survey for 2016.
