

Policy on ProDev Exemption for Senior Members

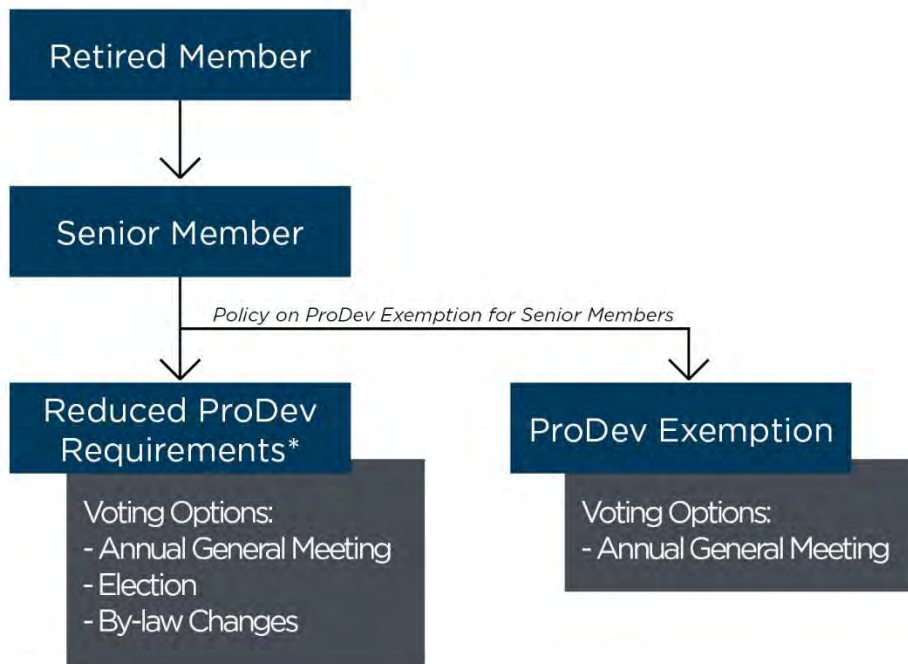
A Senior Member may apply for exemption from ProDev reporting, provided they comply with the following:

- That they provide a written declaration indicating that they are not currently practicing professional engineering or professional geoscience and will not be practicing in the future, and
- That they agree to forego their right to vote on by-law changes and council elections for that calendar year.

To apply, the Senior Member must sign and submit an application form confirming the above. Said application will be reviewed by the Continuing Competency Committee for approval.

Although the Senior Member foregoes their right to vote on by-law changes and council elections, they may still attend meetings of the membership and participate in discussions and voting procedures at those meetings.

A Senior Member must comply with the [Guide to Return to Active Practice \(PDF\)](#) should there be a change in circumstances and should they wish to resume practice in the future.
