

Are you a Student of the Association with submitted Pre-Graduation Experience?

Effective September 15, 2022, pre-graduation experience reports are no longer accepted because of the adoption of the Competency Based Assessment (CBA) process for professional licensure at Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba.

Students from the University of Manitoba and University of Brandon had until September 30, 2022, to submit pre-graduation work experience reports.

First-time engineering and geoscience applicants from these institutions applying to Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba have the option to select either the Pre-Registration Program or the CBA process for licensure only if the applicant:

- 1) Has 12 months of supervisor-approved work experience reports submitted to the Association by March 31, 2023, and
- 2) Graduates no later than December 31, 2024.

First-time applicants who do not meet these conditions will proceed through CBA to gain licensure, if accepted as an intern. Any pre-graduation reports will not be used in the CBA process; however, the content of the reports can be used to prepare the CBA report.
