The Academic Review Committee (ARC) is responsible for reviewing the academic credentials of applicants who hold undergraduate (Bachelor-level) engineering degrees that are not recognized by the CEAB. The ARC also reviews all geoscience related degrees.

The ARC met six times between July 1, 2011 and June 30, 2012. During the year 159 assessment files were reviewed. The ARC reviewed 47 files; the Staff Committee reviewed 112 files. Five interviews were conducted for applicants who had been assigned a confirmatory examination and who appeared to have more than ten years of engineering work experience. In total 110 applicants were deemed academically qualified (87 Engineers and 23 Geoscientists).

The assessment of academic qualifications is, by no means, a simple task, and I therefore would like to sincerely thank the ARC members for their participation and service. I also would like to thank Grant Koropatnick, Sharon Sankar, and Claudia Shymko for their outstanding administrative and logistical support to the ARC.
