A tally of votes submitted on-line and through letter ballots shall be directly supervised by the scrutineers in accordance with a method for counting votes that has been approved by council, is on-file in the association office, and is made available to any practitioner upon request. The scrutineers shall provide a report of the results of the voting to the registrar. The report shall be presented at the annual general meeting. The registrar shall retain letter ballots and on-line voting records for a period of 30 days following the annual general meeting, after which they shall be destroyed.	Creates consistency with By-Law 3.1.7 while recognizing that proportional representation does not apply to voting on bylaw proposals.
