The council shall publish a schedule of regular meetings and shall give at least 24 hours' notice shall be given of all special meetings of the council. Meetings of the council or parts thereof not otherwise declared by the council to be in camera shall be open for professional members, licensees, members-in-training and students to be present as observers, provided that they give 24 hours notice of intention. Where the council holds a meeting or a part thereof in-camera, the reason(s) for having the in-camera meeting shall be noted in the published minutes.
