Neither the office of registrar nor the office of secretary may be combined with that of the chief executive officer.	The CEO is responsible for the day to day operation of the APEGM. It is incumbent on council to monitor performance of the CEO. This is consistent practice for any effective organizational board.	Separating the roles of CEO, Secretary and Registrar adds costs and complexity to the Association's operations without any benefit.
