Charlie Bouskill was born in Calgary, Alberta, in 1929. He graduated from the University of Manitoba with a B.Sc. degree in Mechanical Engineering in 1952 and from the University of Western Ontario with an M.B.A. in 1956.

Charlie was registered with APEM on June 20, 1956, and has been a member continuously for 41 years. He has been a member of the Engineering Institute of Canada since 1952, a Senior Member of the American Institute of Industrial Engineers since 1965, a Member of the Canadian Society of Mechanical Engineers since 1971, and a Warden of The Ritual of The Calling of an Engineer from 1972 (Chief Warden 1992/1993, and Honorary Warden from 1993).

Charlie was a member of Council from 1973 to 1977, and was President in 1976. He served on the Executive & Finance Committee for four years, the Board of Examiners for 11 years (including three years as Chair), the Ad Hoc Committee on Registration Procedures for two years, the Ad Hoc Committee on Academic Qualifications for Industrial & Computer Engineering for two years, the Admissions/Experience Review Board for 15 years (one year as Chair), the Practice & Ethics/Investigation Committee for 11 years (two years as its first Chair), the Ad Hoc Code of Ethics Review Committee for seven years (five years as Chair), the Awards Committee for seven years (one year as Chair), the Nominating Committee for five years (one year as Chair), the Salary Guidelines Committee for two years, the Ad Hoc Committees of Past Presidents for three years, the Ad Hoc Premises Committee for four years (two years as Chair), and as CCPE Representative for one year, Chair of the APEM/MANSCETT Liaison Committee for four years, Chair of the Ad Hoc Committee on the Log of Experience for three years, Chair of the Ad Hoc Discipline Review Committee for five years, as well as being staff support to the Investigation Committee for the past five years. This totals an incredible 97 committee years of service to the Association. It comes as no surprise that Charlie was the first member of APEM to receive the Outstanding Service Award in 1971.

In addition to his activities in the APEM, Charlie has been actively involved in his church and was elected an Elder in 1947. He has been a member and officer in the Masonic Order since 1951; a Cub Pack Instructor for ten years; and a Councillor for the Village of Dunnottar for five years. He retired in 1992 from his position as Support Services Manager for Centra Gas Manitoba Inc. (formerly part of Inter-City Gas Corporation).

Honorary Life Membership is granted to Charlie Bouskill in recognition of his commendable service to the Association and to his profession in Canada.
