

## CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS

Are you interested in volunteering? If so, Engineer Geoscientists Manitoba is looking for volunteers to assist with the Future City Experience.

The Future City Competition challenges students in grades 6, 7, and 8 across Canada to use the engineering design process to research, design, and build a model of city 100 years into the future. Students in this year's challenge are to design a lunar city and provide examples of how the city uses two moon resources to keep its residents safe and healthy.

### General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Serve as a mentor to participants.
- Answer questions and provide advice to the students as they work through their build.
- Share your experience in the engineering field.

### Specific Skills and Qualifications

- Be either a professional engineer or engineering intern.
- Enjoy working with children.
- Work well with others.
- Ability to have fun.

### Time Commitment

Volunteers must commit to two virtual one-hour class visits in February and March 2021 and must also commit to supporting the Future City Experience Showcase in May, where students present their city models and receive feedback from engineers (approximately a four-hour commitment). Additional time may be required as you work individually with the student(s) during their build.
