

# HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP

Life Membership, *Honoris Causa*, is granted by unanimous decision of Council to a member who has, in the opinion of Council, rendered meritorious service to the Association; who is no longer practising on a full-time basis as a Professional Engineer; who has preferably been continuously a member for not less than 35 years; and who has attained the age of 65.

## George Alois De Pauw

George De Pauw was registered with this Association on May 20, 1954 and has been a continuous member for 38 years.

George was a member of Council from 1972 to 1975 and from 1985 to 1986 (6 years), and was President in 1974. He served on the Salary Committee for one year; the Nominating Committee for three years; the Executive/Finance Committee for four years; the CCPE Annual Meeting Committee for one year; the CCPE Affairs Committee for three years; the Awards Committee for eight years; the Compensation Study Ad Hoc Committee for one year; the Employee Engineers Committee for one year: a total of 28 committee years of service.
