

Notice under the Engineering and Geoscientific Professions Act

This Notice is provided in accordance with Section 36.2(1) of *The Engineering and Geoscientific Professions Act*.

This is Notice that on July 28, 2026, Eng-Tech Consulting Ltd. was formally cautioned by the Association's Investigation Committee. The Formal Caution relates to Eng-Tech's involvement in the design and preparation of an as-built report for a subdivision development in rural Manitoba.

The Committee determined that Eng-Tech Consulting Ltd. did not apply the minimum standard of care required in the undertaking of this work. Specifically, Eng-Tech failed to exercise due diligence in discussions with the client regarding the proposed alignment of the road to support the client's design review and approval process. Furthermore, Eng-Tech issued an as-built report without having verified that the road was in compliance with its design drawing specifications.

The Committee determined that Eng-Tech demonstrated conduct that is detrimental to the public interest, as well as a lack of knowledge of or lack of skill or judgment in the practice of professional engineering, in violation of s. 46(1)(a) and (e) of *The Engineering and Geoscientific Professions Act*.
