

FAMILY LEGACY BURSARY DRAW

OVERVIEW

The Family Legacy Bursary is designed to assist students who are continuing their family's tradition in the engineering or geoscience professions. Each year five bursaries valued at \$2,500 each are awarded by random draw. Please note that these bursaries are non-renewable.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Applicants must be children of Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba members who are in good standing. Grandchildren and in-laws are not eligible for this bursary.
- Applicants must be Canadian residents and must be enrolled full-time in the first year of an engineering or geoscience program at a CEAB accredited Canadian university or college.
- Only one entry per applicant is allowed. Multiple entries for the same applicant will not be accepted.
- For the purpose of this bursary, "members" does not include interns, temporary licensees, or specified scope of practice licensees.

DEADLINE: September 1st of each year.
