

## **FAMILY LEGACY BURSARY DRAW APPLICATION FORM**

The purpose of the bursary is to assist students who are continuing the professional lineage in their immediate family. Five (5) bursary awards of \$1,000 each will be given annually. The awards are non-renewable. Bursary recipients will be selected by random draw shortly after the deadline of September 1.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- Open to the children of Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba members, in good standing.
- Students must be enrolled full time in 1<sup>st</sup> year engineering or geoscience studies at a CEAB recognized university or college.
- Students can only enter the draw once; no repeat entries will be accepted.
- The bursary is not available to grandchildren nor in-laws.
- For the purposes of this bursary, "members" do not include the categories of intern, temporary licensee, or specified scope of practice.
