ABOUT THE SENIOR MEMBER CATEGORY

Professional members who meet the following criteria may enter the Senior Member category. Senior Members must:

- a) be in good standing;
- b) have been registered as a professional member of the Association, or as a member of one of the constituent associations of Engineers Canada, or in the case of a professional geoscientist have practised, for a period of not less than thirty (30) years.

If a member in the Senior Member category wishes to resume practice, they must follow the Return to Active Practice Guideline. Please refer to www.EngGeoMB.ca/Reinstatement.html.

Dues

Annual dues can be waived if, at renewal, the senior member provides annual written confirmation to the Association that they have not, for remuneration, engaged in the practice of professional engineering and/or professional geoscience, as applicable, for more than 300 hours over the course of the preceding 12 months.

Senior members who confirm that they are receiving remuneration on a full time or regular basis (greater than 300 hours per calendar year) in the practice of professional engineering and/or professional geoscience, will be required to pay the same dues as a general member.

ProDev Requirements

By default, senior members are required to report reduced professional development hours. Please refer to the Policy on Reduced Professional Development Reporting Targets at www.EngGeoMB.ca/ProDevSeniorMember.html.

<u>Certificate of Authorization Requirements</u>

As per section 16(1)(b)(ii) of the Act, to be listed as a responsible member for a Certificate of Authorization, the professional member must be "a partner or full-time employee of the partnership or a full-time employee of the corporation or other entity". Should you confirm you are no longer receiving remuneration on a full-time or regular basis in the practice of engineering and/or geoscience, you no longer meet the requirement of the Act to be listed as a responsible member for a Certificate of Authorization, and you will be removed as a responsible member or your Certificate of Authorization may be canceled.
