Are you a registered engineer interested in volunteering? Are you in need of professional development hours for ProDev? If so, the Association is looking for professional members to join the Academic Review Committee.

Academic Review Committee

Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba is establishing an Academic Review Committee as part of anticipated updates to academic criteria and the academic assessment program in the Manual of Admissions, expected to come into effect July 1, 2025. The Academic Review Committee will be a committee of the Registrar/CEO, which will support and provide recommendations to the Registration Committee in determining if first-time applicants for enrolment as an intern are academically qualified.

Members will be from a cross-section of academic disciplines and workplace sectors. At least two members will be academic staff from a Manitoba university, including at least one engineering and one geoscience member.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for reviewing and recommending changes to academic eligibility requirements
 of the Manual of Admissions and the Association's academic assessment program.
- Members will individually review academic assessments conducted by Admissions
 assessment staff to confirm if an applicant meets the academic requirements and will
 recommend if a confirmatory program is needed for an applicant to meet the academic
 requirements.
- The Committee will also conduct an annual audit of the results of the assessment program.

Specific Skills and Qualifications:

- Registered as a professional member (P.Eng. or P.Geo.) and in good standing with the Association.
- Compliant with ProDev.
- Have an awareness of current academic requirements, practice standards, employer contexts, and workplace cultures, in either engineering or geoscience.
- Able to commit to reviewing files on a regular basis and attending meetings.



Time Commitment:

The Committee is expected to meet as needed, at least two times per year, virtually or in person. Members of the Committee will be individually assigned files throughout the year based on their discipline of practice and will submit their assessment for consideration by the Registration Committee, following established assessment guidelines and criteria based on Engineers Canada and Geoscientists Canada knowledge requirements. Appointments are for a three-year term, and a person may be appointed for one additional three-year term.
