APPEAL COMMITTEE

The Appeal Committee is responsible for hearing appeals made by:

- applicants regarding registration decisions, and
- complainants regarding decisions made by the Investigation Committee.

This committee fulfills one of the core functions of Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba, as mandated by the Act and by-laws. Appeal Committee members determine, as a panel, whether to uphold, modify, or overturn decisions made by the Registration Committee, Registrar, or Investigation Committee.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

As an Appeal Committee member, you will work as a panel of three to review appeals. With the assistance of legal counsel, the panel

- hears arguments from applicants, complainants, and investigated persons,
- reviews witness testimony,
- considers legal precedence, and
- makes a written decision.

Specific Skills and Qualifications

- A professional member licensed with EngGeoMB (P.Eng. or P.Geo.)
- 10+ years of professional practice is required
- Knowledge of the Act and by-laws
- Some knowledge of the judicial process
- Previous experience on EngGeoMB committees is preferred

Time Commitment:

The workload for Appeal Committee members depends on the volume of charges made against investigated persons. Participation in a hearing will be infrequent, however, when a hearing is required, a full day may be required to hear the matter.
