Are you interested in having a positive impact on the engineering profession nationwide? The Canadian Engineering Qualifications Board (CEQB) is seeking a representative from Manitoba to bring their unique perspective and expertise to its national committee.

Canadian Engineering Qualifications Board

As a standing committee under the Engineers Canada Board, the CEQB plays a crucial role in developing [national guidelines](#), Engineers Canada papers, and [examination syllabi](#) to support the assessment of engineering qualifications and to promote excellence in the practice and regulation of the profession. This work serves and responds to the needs of Canada's engineering regulators.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

As a CEQB member, you would help guide the development of critical resources in areas such as:

- Admissions;
- Foreign credential recognition;
- The professional practice examination;
- Engineers-in-training;
- Continuing competence and professional development;
- Practice of engineering;
- Sustainability and the environment.
- The code of ethics; and,
- Other issues of national importance as identified by the Regulators.

The CEQB is committed to upholding the purpose and values of Engineers Canada, including the principles of equity, diversity, and inclusion. This aligns with Engineers Canada's Board's [official commitment](#) to the Federal Government's [50-30 Challenge](#). The CEQB is comprised of individuals with diverse perspectives and experience, including those with industry and academic backgrounds, those who are working and retired, and those who have been trained as engineers in Canada and abroad. Recognizing the benefits of diverse teams, the CEQB is committed to creating an inclusive environment that fosters innovation and better serves the public interest through both policy and practice.

Specific Skills and Qualifications:

- Be a professional engineer (P.Eng.) in good standing with the Association
- Have a keen interest in issues surrounding engineering qualifications and/or practice (e.g. assessment of applicants, ethics, sustainability)
- Ideally have served on a board of examiners or its equivalent
- Have engineering work experience in industry and/or academia
- Have a good understanding and/or interest in engineering regulation in Canada
- Ability to conduct all communications and meetings in English

Time Commitment:

- Members of the CEQB are appointed for three-year terms (renewable once) by the Engineers Canada Board, based on recommendations of the CEQB Nominating Committee.
- On average, a CEQB member should expect to attend four CEQB meetings per year (two in-person meetings, and two virtual meetings), plus quarterly participation on committees (virtual).
