Future City Competition

The Future City Competition challenges students in grades 6, 7, and 8 across Canada to use the engineering design process to research, design, and build a model of a city 100 years into the future. Students in this year's challenge are to design a zero-waste city and provide examples of how the city reuses waste resources to keep its residents safe and healthy.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Serve as a role model and mentor to participants.
- Answer questions and provide advice to the students as they work through their build.
- Share your experience in the engineering field.

Specific Skills and Qualifications

- Be either a professional engineer or engineering intern.
- Enjoy working with children.
- Work well with others.
- Ability to have fun.

Time Commitment

Volunteers must commit to three virtual one-hour class visits between February and April 2023 and must also commit to supporting the Future City Experience Showcase on May 10, where students present their city models and receive feedback from engineers (approximately a two-hour commitment).

Volunteers will be provided with everything they need to support their class. You will also be invited to attend a live training session (week of January 30) to prepare you for the program and answer any questions you may have.
