### **Investigation Committee**

The Investigation Committee reviews complaints regarding the conduct of members and provides recommendations on disciplinary actions based on the nature and severity of the matter. The committee is a statutory committee of Council and includes registered professionals from a range of engineering and geoscience disciplines.

#### General Duties and Responsibilities

As a member of the Investigation Committee, you will:

- Assist in the review, consideration, and decision-making process for complaints against members
- Contribute to discussions and recommendations regarding professional conduct matters
- Provide guidance related to standards of professional practice and ethics

#### Specific Skills and Qualifications:

- Registered as a P.Eng. in good standing with the Association.
- Have knowledge of the Act and By-laws
- Have some familiarity with judicial or quasi-judicial processes
- Be available to attend meetings
- Be willing to actively contribute to committee discussions and decisions

#### Time Commitment:

- The committee meets monthly, with meeting times determined by the committee chair. Members are also expected to review materials in advance of meetings. Subcommittees may occasionally be formed and may require additional meetings or file review time.
- Committee members are appointed for two-year terms and may be reappointed for up to four consecutive terms.
