NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The Nominating Committee assists Council in identifying election candidates who meet the criteria for councillors as described in the Governance Policy, in a manner consistent with the Act and By-laws, and taking into consideration the broadest possible diversity of the membership.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Produce a suitable slate of candidates for the upcoming election, replacing any vacancies on Council.
- Contact potential candidates to explain the role of the councillor, the opportunity to govern, election processes, time commitments, and other related details.
- Report back whether potential candidates are willing to stand for election should the committee select them as a preferred candidate.

Specific Skills and Qualifications:

- Four new committee members are needed.
 - Spots are limited to one intern (engineering or geoscience) and three professional members, one of which being a P.Geo.
- Candidates have a well-connected network with other professional members.
- An understanding of governance, succession planning, and board/Council functions.
- Experience in the field of Human Resources, specifically in the areas of screening applicants, interviewing, and selection.

Time Commitment:

The Nominating Committee will meet approximately three to four times between the months of April and May, with meetings typically lasting 1 and a half hours.
