### NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The Nominating Committee is a committee of Council, who assists Council in identifying election candidates who meet the criteria for councillors as described in the Governance Policy, in a manner consistent with the Act and By-laws, and taking into consideration the broadest possible diversity of the membership.

Four (4) new committee members are needed.

- Three professional members, one of which being a P.Geo.
- One intern (engineering or geoscience)

## **General Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Produce a suitable slate of candidates for the upcoming election.
- Contact potential candidates to explain the role of the councillor, the election processes, time commitments, and other related details.
- Report back to the committee whether potential candidates are willing to stand for election should the committee select them as a preferred candidate.

#### Specific Skills and Qualifications:

- Candidates should have a well-connected network with other professional members.
- Candidates should have a basic understanding of governance, succession planning, and board/Council functions.
- Experience in the field of Human Resources, (i.e., screening applicants, interviewing, and selection) is preferred but not required.

#### <u>Time Commitment:</u>

The Nominating Committee meets approximately four times between the months of April and June, with meetings typically lasting an hour.
