NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The Nominating Committee is a committee of Council, which assists in identifying election candidates who meet the criteria for new councillors as described in the Governance Policy for Councillor Roles and Job Description, GP-6.

The Nominating Committee is looking for three (3) professional members, of which one needs to be a professional geoscientist. The committee is also looking for one (1) Intern (engineering or geoscience).

Time Commitment:

The term of office for this committee is one year, where the committee will meet approximately 3-4 times between the months of April and May, with meetings typically lasting 1 ½ hours.

General Duties and Responsibilities

- Produce a slate of qualified candidates for Council election for review at the June Council meeting, that is in a manner consistent with the Act and by-laws, taking into consideration the broadest possible diversity of the membership.
- Contact potential candidates to explain the role of the councillor, the election processes, time commitments, and other related details.
- Report back to the committee whether potential candidates are willing to stand for election should the committee select them as a preferred candidate.

Specific Skills and Qualifications

- Candidates should have a well-connected network with other professional members.
- Candidates should have a basic understanding of governance, succession planning, and board/Council functions.
- Experience in the field of Human Resources, (i.e., screening applicants, interviewing, and selection) is preferred but not required.
