

# CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS

## **Registration Committee**

The Registration Committee (RC) is a committee of Council, responsible for conducting the final review for members and Interns who are moving forward towards final registration. The RC is made up of registered professionals from all engineering and geoscience disciplines.

### **General Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Review documentation provided by the applicant and recommend these files for registration by Council.
- Participate in regular monthly meetings with the RC to discuss issues and policy development related to the committee.
- Where required, participate in registration and reinstatement appeals.

### **Specific Skills and Qualifications**

- A professional engineer designation (P.Eng.) or a professional geoscientist designation (P.Geo.) in good standing with the Association.
- All disciplines are encouraged to apply, but the professional members with expertise in mining, mechanical/HVAC, geological engineers or geoscientists are most needed.
- This volunteer position is ideal for individuals who are committed to assisting Interns and members to move forward in the registration process.
- Availability to commit to reviewing files on a regular basis
- Availability for meetings either in person or virtually.

## Time Commitment:

The committee meets every month (12 times a year) with the meetings running approximately one to two hours in length. Meetings are typically the last Wednesday of the month and are held over the lunch hour. Meetings are currently being held virtually by MS Teams.
