Registration Committee

The Registration Committee (RC) is a committee of Council, responsible for conducting the final review of applicants and interns moving forward towards final registration. The RC includes registered professionals from various engineering and geoscience disciplines.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Review applicant documentation and recommend applicants for registration by Council.
- Participate in regular monthly meetings with the RC to discuss assigned files, issues, and policy development related to the committee.
- Where required, participate in registration and reinstatement appeals.

Specific Skills and Qualifications

- A professional geoscientist (P.Geo.) in good standing with the Association.
- Availability to commit to reviewing files on a regular basis.
- Availability for meetings either in person or virtually.
- This volunteer position is ideal for individuals who are committed to assisting Interns and members to move forward in the registration process.

Time Commitment:

The committee meets every month (12 times a year) with the meetings running approximately one to two hours in length. Meetings are typically the last Wednesday of the month and are held over the lunch hour. Meetings are currently being held virtually by MS Teams or hybrid (in-person with virtual option). Additional time will be required to review assigned files prior to meetings.
