Registration Committee

The Registration Committee (RC) is a committee of Council, responsible for conducting the final review of applicants and interns moving forward towards final registration. The RC includes registered professionals from various engineering and geoscience disciplines.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Review applicant documentation and recommend applicants for registration by Council.
- Participate in regular monthly meetings with the RC to discuss assigned files, issues, and policy development related to the committee.
- As required, participate in registration and reinstatement appeals.

Specific Skills and Qualifications:

- A professional engineer (P.Eng.) in good standing with the Association, **specifically in the** areas of electrical engineering.
- Availability to commit to reviewing files on a monthly basis.
- Availability for monthly meeting either in person or virtually.
- This volunteer position is ideal for individuals who are committed to assisting Interns and members with moving forward in the registration process.

Time Commitment:

The committee meets every month (12 times a year) with meetings one to two hours in length. Meetings are typically the last Wednesday of the month and are held over the lunch hour. Meetings are currently being held virtually by MS Teams or hybrid (in-person with virtual option). Additional time is required to review assigned files prior to meetings.
