Are you a registered geoscientist interested in volunteering and giving back to the profession? If so, the Association is looking for a professional geoscientist (P.Geo.) to join the Registration Committee.

Registration Committee

The Registration Committee (RC) is a committee of Council responsible for conducting the final review of applicants and interns progressing toward registration and licensure. The RC includes registered professionals from various engineering and geoscience disciplines, as well as lay persons.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Review applicant documentation and provide recommendations on applicants for intern enrollment, registration and licensure.
- Participate in monthly meetings to discuss assigned files, issues, and policies related to the committee, registration and licensure.
- Where required, participate in intern enrollment, registration and reinstatement appeals.

Specific Skills and Qualifications:

- A professional geoscientist (P.Geo.) in good standing with the Association.
- Availability to commit to reviewing files in advance of meetings.
- Availability for meetings either in person or virtually.
- Committed to assisting qualified applicants moving forward in the registration process.
- Knowledge of competency-based assessment (CBA) is an asset.

Time Commitment:

The committee meets every month (12 times a year) with the meetings running approximately one to two hours in length. Meetings are typically the last Wednesday of the month and are held over the lunch hour. Meetings are currently being held virtually by MS Teams or hybrid (in-person with virtual option). Additional time will be required to review assigned files prior to meetings. There is a two-year term commitment.
